

As a Tower Climber Technician you will be responsible for a full range of installation, repair and maintenance

services on towers including but not limited to:

- Work with Construction Manager and Foreman to analyze job requirements such as labor and materials.
- Read Plans, Site Plans, and Tower Drawings
- Install, connect, and test underground and above ground grounding systems
- Ensure Foreman is apprised of construction progress, concerns, and deviations from plans or established schedule
- Perform tower construction activities including assembling/erecting towers, installing antennas, mounting hardware, installing coax and connectors, grounding, testing, positioning, and optimizing antennas and lines
- Safely and efficiently complete repairs and upgrades at elevated heights
- Maintain and enforce all OSHA safety practices, perform daily job-site safety inspections on equipment prior to operation
- Follow instructions to accomplish assigned work in a timely and accurate manner
- Maintain proper use of company vehicles and other assets
- Pre-Work and Post-Work site audits
- Site upgrades and capacity expansion
- Ability and willingness to train team members, and work collaboratively with crew and management
- Conducting repair and maintenance on lighting systems
- Troubleshooting, replacing and performing maintenance on 4G components, coax, jumpers, TMA's, connectors,
- weatherproofing etc.
- Analyzes situations accurately and adopts an appropriate course of action.
- Knowledge of basic tower rigging techniques
- Assists with testing procedures (sweeps, PIM, fiber testing etc.)
- Performs GPS antenna alignment.
- Proficient with installation of antennas, RRH's, ground kits, RET systems.
- Runs required lines to top of the tower; grounds coax lines and builds different sizes and types of connectors.

Physical Requirements:

- Valid driver's license and a driving record that is satisfactory to the company's vehicle insurance carrier
- Ability to commute to headquarters
- Infield training and experience, 2+ years preferred
- Ability to work at heights of up to 500 ft.
- Able to lift up to 70lb

Qualifications:

- High School Diploma or Equivalent (required)

- Valid Driver's License
- Computer Literacy (required for positions that involve the use of a computer)
- Strong written and oral communication skills
- Ability to work effectively in a team environment
- Good reading and writing skills
- Clean Driving Record and valid Driver's License (a must) and reliable transportation to and from work.
- Working knowledge of basic hand tools, mechanical equipment, and electro-mechanical equipment.
